



UNIFORM GUIDELINES

The correct wearing of the College uniform is an agreed condition of enrolment at the College. Our uniform assists in the maintenance of certain minimum standards of personal presentation. The College has a well-designed, smart looking uniform which should be worn by all students with pride. At Wollondilly, we accept that the College uniform is one expression of – “This is where I belong and that I am proud of where I belong.”

Pre-Kindergarten (Transition)

ALL-SEASON UNIFORM

Pre-Kindergarten wear an all-season uniform, with items to be worn as the weather dictates, although typically shorts are worn in Terms 1 and 4, and sport jacket and long pants are worn in Terms 2 and 3.

Option 1 - Predominantly white joggers

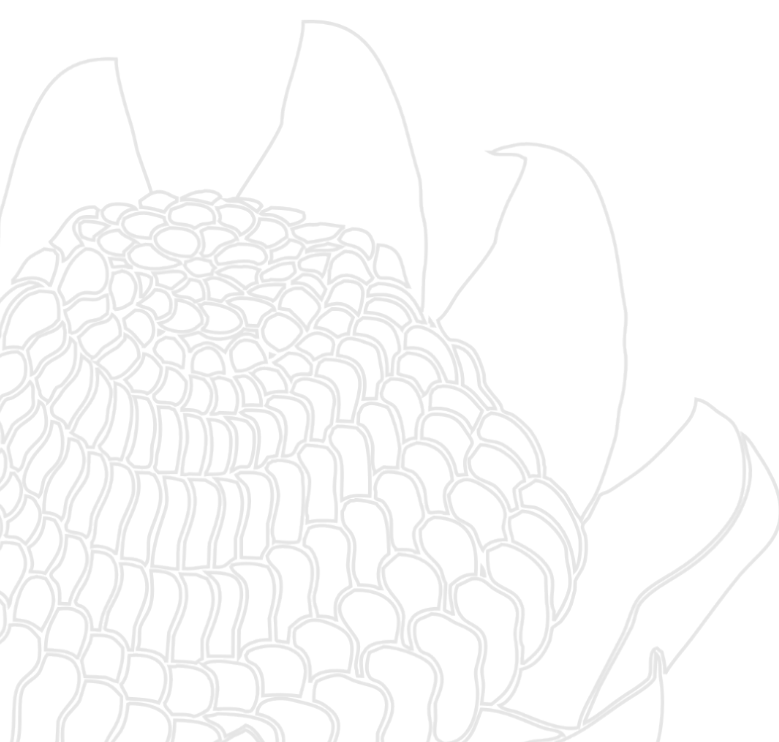

SUMMER UNIFORM

Option 1 - College summer dress – length must be below the knee

Option 2 – College tartan culottes

College white, short sleeved blouse – fully buttoned up & tucked in

Jacket: optional during summer:

Kindergarten to Year 4: College green, bomber style jacket

Years 5 & 6: College green blazer

College green jumper – optional to be worn if cold, but should be worn under jacket/blazer

College socks, white with green stripe

Shoes: Black, polishable leather, flat-heeled, lace up shoes (*Only Kindergarten to Year 2 have the option of Velcro fastenings – no buckles*). Black joggers, street, skate or casual style shoes are NOT permitted and do not meet WHS requirements. Shoes should be polished regularly.

WINTER UNIFORM

Option 1 - College Primary tunic – length must be below the knee

Black opaque tights above knee (bare legs not to be seen)

Option 2 – College tartan pants

College socks, white with green stripe

College Primary white, long sleeved blouse – buttoned

College tartan tab tie – fastened under the collar, placed directly over the top button of blouse

Jacket: to be worn to and from the College, at all assemblies, Chapel and College functions:

Kindergarten to Year 4: College green, bomber style jacket

Years 5 & 6: College Green Blazer

College green jumper – optional to be worn if cold, but should be worn under jacket

Black overcoat - optional to be worn if cold

Shoes: Black, polishable leather, flat-heeled, lace up shoes (*Only Kindergarten to Year 2 have the option of Velcro fastenings – no buckles*). Black joggers, street, skate or casual style shoes are NOT permitted and do not meet WHS requirements. Shoes should be polished regularly.

MISCELLANEOUS

Length: Dress and tunic lengths must be below the knee.

Earrings: One small, plain gold or silver stud or sleeper (no clasp) in each earlobe only. No other piercing of any type is permitted.

Other Jewellery: No chains, rings, ankle or wrist bracelets or body piercings are allowed at any time.

Tattoos: No visible tattoos.

Nails: To be an appropriate length and without coloured nail polish. No fake nails.

Hair:

Should be one natural colour (original or close to original), no streaks

Hair styles should not be extreme and should be off the face

Hair styles should allow hats to be worn easily

Hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back for safety reasons

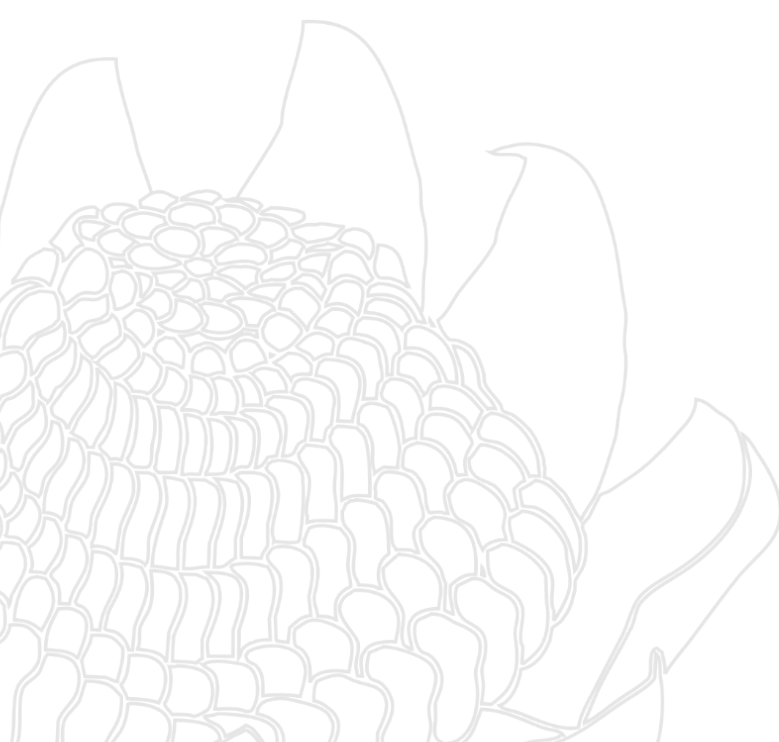
No undercuts

Hair adornments - College ribbon (available to purchase from Student Reception), black hair ties or black scrunchies only. The exception is for sports carnival days where House colour adornments are welcomed and encouraged.

Faces: Students are not to wear make-up. Light foundation, as close as possible to natural skin colour, is permitted. No mascara or false eyelashes.

Gloves: Plain black gloves are permitted in winter - optional

SPORT UNIFORM

College House polo shirt:

Kindergarten to Year 2: all sport days, Carnivals, Foundation Day & House Days

Year 3 to 6: PDHPE days, Carnivals, Foundation Day & House Days

College white polo shirt: *Years 3 to 6 only:* sports day, PDHPE days, representative teams & some excursions

College black shorts – length just above the knee

College sport long pants – optional in summer, compulsory in winter

College sport jacket – optional in summer, compulsory in winter

College sport socks

College knee length green socks (worn to the knee) for some representative teams (e.g.: soccer, hockey) - available at Student Reception

Shoes:

Option 1 - Predominantly white joggers

Option 2 - Predominantly black joggers

Street, skate or casual style shoes are NOT accepted

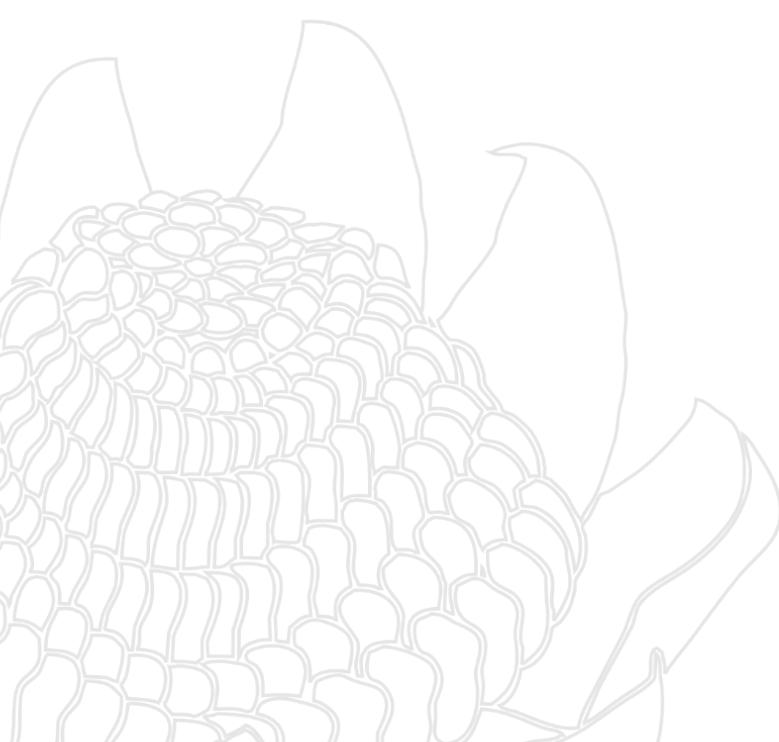

College light green, short sleeved shirt - tucked in

College grey summer shorts

Jacket: optional during summer:

Kindergarten to Year 4: College green, bomber style jacket

Years 5 & 6: College green blazer

College grey socks

Shoes: Black, polishable leather, flat-heeled, lace up shoes (*Only Kindergarten to Year 2 have the option of Velcro fastenings – no buckles*). Black joggers, street, skate or casual style shoes are NOT permitted and do not meet WHS requirements. Shoes should be polished regularly.

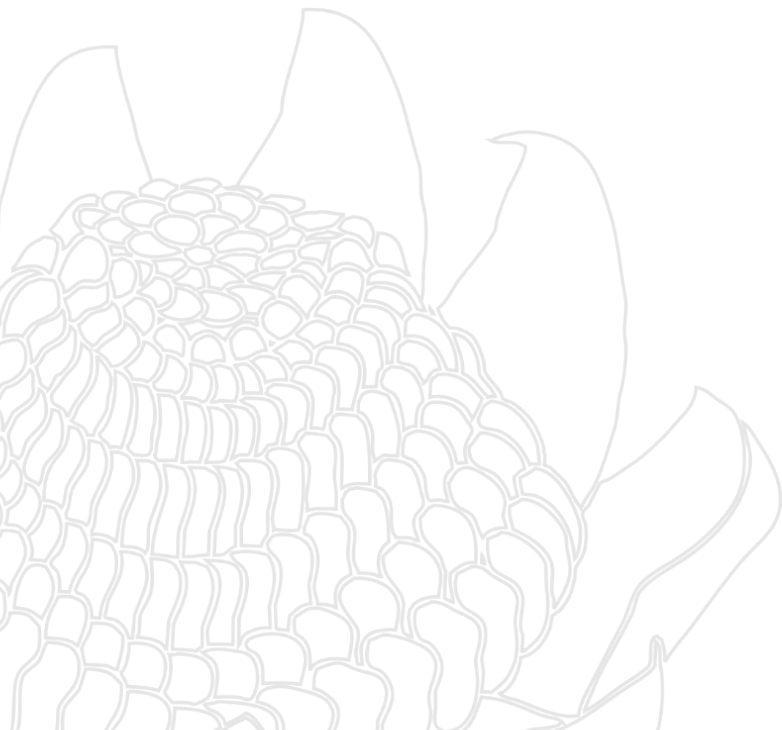

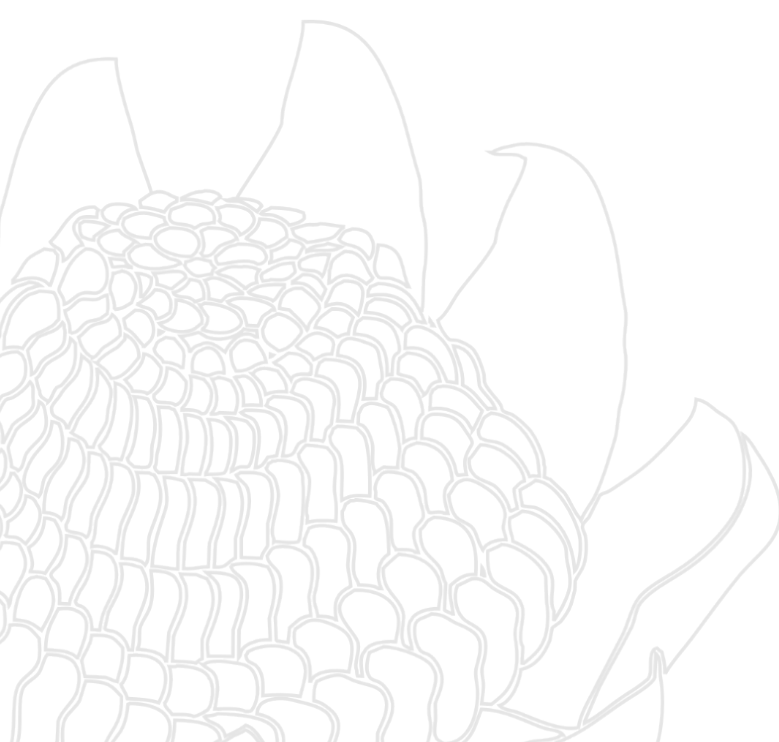

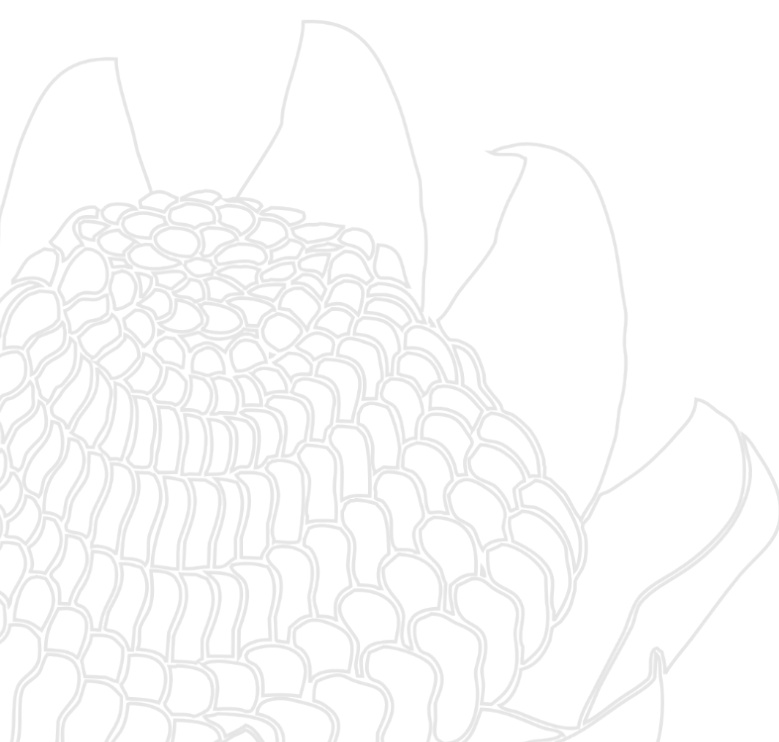

College white polo shirt (sports afternoons, representative teams, some excursions & PDHPE practical lessons if applicable)

College black shorts - length just above the knee

College sport long pants - optional in summer, compulsory in winter

College sport jacket - optional in summer, compulsory in winter

College sport socks

College knee length green socks (worn to the knee) for some representative teams (e.g.: soccer, hockey) - available at Student Reception

Shoes:

Option 1 - Predominantly white joggers

Option 2 - Predominantly black joggers

Street, skate or casual style shoes are NOT accepted

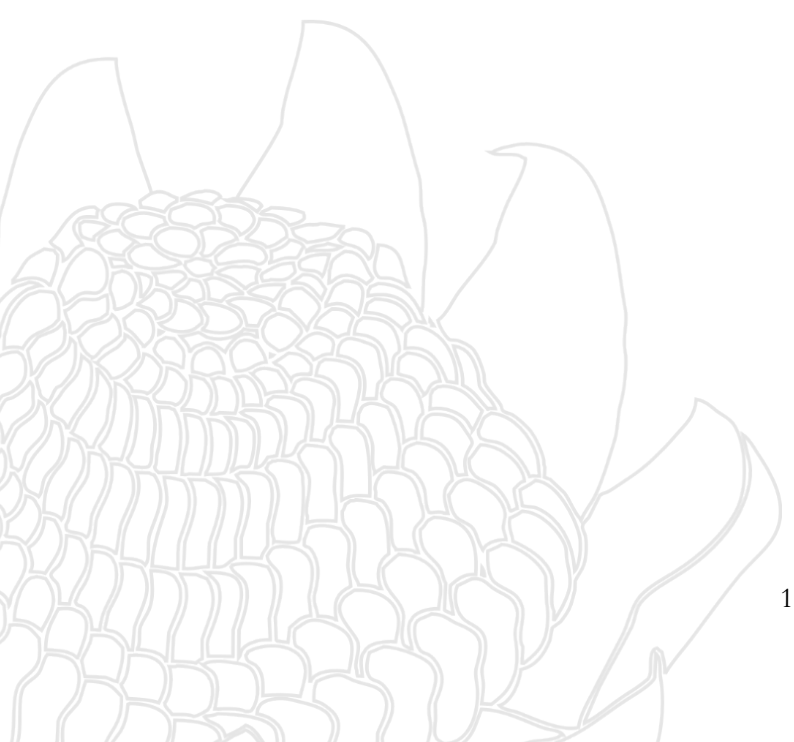
Please note, for safety during practical Science and TAS lessons, students are required to wear shoes made of leather. This includes Tuesday (sport day). While there is no expectation for sport shoes to be leather, students will be required to bring/change into leather school shoes on sport and PE days.

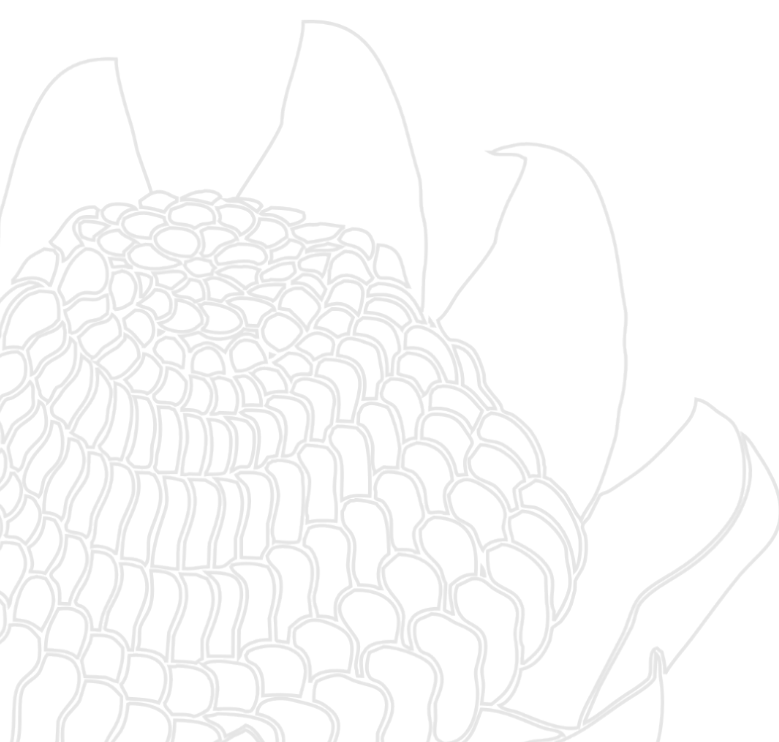

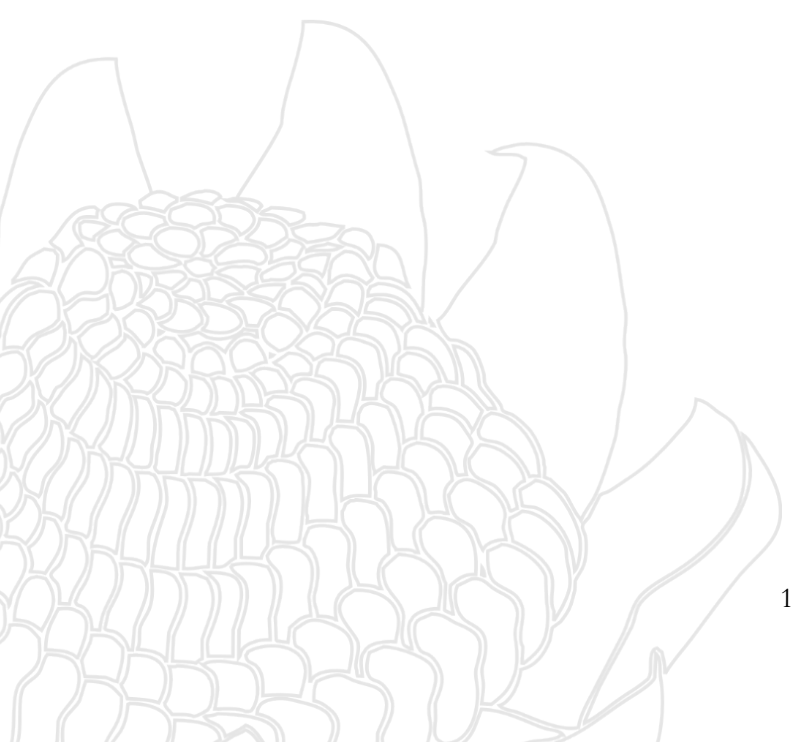

Student Safety Process – Modified Footwear

The College is committed to ensuring a safe learning environment for all students in accordance with Work Health and Safety (WHS) standards.

If a student is unable to wear the standard shoes in accordance with these Uniform Guidelines due to a medically diagnosed injury (e.g. requiring a leg cast or moon boot), parents/carers must make contact with the College Nurse prior to the student's return to the College.

To ensure appropriate support and safety for students, formal medical documentation must be provided specifying the following:

- the nature of the injury,
- the exact type of prescribed footwear, and
- the expected duration of the recovery period.

This documentation must be in the form of a letter from a qualified medical professional.

For safety reasons, slide-style shoes, Crocs, thongs or wearing socks only, are strictly prohibited on College grounds as they do not provide the necessary support or foot protection.

Furthermore, students wearing modified footwear or casts require a safety assessment for practical subjects such as Science, Technology subjects or PDHPE/PASS.

In instances where a student's footwear does not comply with the WHS safety requirements for these high-risk environments, alternative arrangements or classes may be necessary until they can safely return to standard protective footwear.
