Transition

ALL SEASON UNIFORM

Transition wear an all season uniform, with items to be worn as the weather dictates, although typically shorts are worn in Terms 1 and 4, and tracksuit jacket and long pants are worn in Terms 2 and 3.

College socks, white with green band

Jacket: *Kindergarten to Year 4:* College green, bomber style jacket – optional during Summer
Years 5 & 6: College green blazer – optional during Summer

College Green Jumper – optional to be worn if cold, but should only be worn under jacket

Hat: Green slouch to be worn to and from the College, for all assemblies and in the playground

Raincoat: Full length, yellow raincoat

Shoes: Black, polishable leather flat heeled lace up shoes. Black joggers or skate style shoes are NOT permitted and do not meet WHS requirements. Shoes should be polished regularly.

WINTER UNIFORM

College Primary Tunic – length must be mid calf/ankle

College White Blouse - buttoned

Black opaque tights above knee (bare legs not to be seen)

Jacket: *Kindergarten to Year 4:* College green, bomber style jacket – to be worn to and from the College and at all assemblies, Chapel and College functions
Years 5 & 6: College Green Blazer - to be worn to and from the College and at all assemblies, Chapel and College functions

College green jumper – optional to be worn if cold, but should only be worn under jacket

Hat: green slouch to be worn to and from the College, for all assemblies and in the playground

College tartan tab tie – fastened under the collar, placed directly over the top button of blouse

Raincoat: full length, yellow raincoat

Shoes: Black, polishable leather flat heeled lace up shoes. Black joggers or skate style shoes are NOT permitted and do not meet WHS requirements. Shoes should be polished regularly.

MISCELLANEOUS

Length: Dress lengths will be checked to comply with the guidelines.

Jewellery: No chains, rings, ankle or wrist bracelets or body piercings are allowed at any time.

Piercings: One gold or silver stud or sleeper in each earlobe only.
Clear earrings are NOT permitted.

Tattoos: No visible tattoos.

Nails: To be an appropriate length and without coloured nail polish. No fake or false nails.

Hair: Should be one natural colour (original or close to original), no streaks.
Hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back at the nape of the neck for safety reasons. Hair styles should not be extreme and should be off the face.
Should not cover their eyes. Should allow a hat to be worn easily.
Should not be excessively spiked or messy. No undercuts allowed.
Hair adornments - College ribbon (available to purchase from Student Reception) or black scrunchie only. The exception is for sports carnival days where House colours are welcomed and encouraged.

Faces: Students are not to wear make-up. Light foundation, as close as possible to natural skin colour, is permitted if written permission from parents is provided to the Year Patron. No fake eyelashes.

Shoes: black, polishable leather flat heeled lace up shoes. Black joggers or skate style shoes are NOT permitted and do not meet WHS requirements. Shoes should be polished regularly.
