



Peripatetic Music Tutor Contractors – Commencing February 2022

As part of our commitment to deliver quality music lessons and innovative education at Wollondilly Anglican College, an exciting opportunity exists for Instrumental Music Specialists to assist our Music team as a contractor on a part-time basis.

The College is currently seeking applications for the following positions:

- Brass tutor (up to 1 day per week)
- Vocal tutor (1 to 2 days per week)
- Tuned Percussion tutor, including Timpani (up to 1 day per week)
- Flute tutor (up to 1 day per week)

Specialist Music Tutors are to undertake this role in keeping with the College Strategic Plan as directed by the Headmaster, as well as the Music Department Strategic Plan as directed by the Creative Arts Coordinator and Performing Arts Coordinator (T-12).

Specialist Music Tutors will work in conjunction with other Music Faculty, Instrumental Music and Ensemble staff, and other College staff to form a creative and collaborative approach to the learning journey of every student.

Key Responsibilities of the Role:

- Help guide students through processes such as external examinations with AMEB, Trinity etc.
- Develop positive relationships with students that promote confidence and pride in belonging to the Wollondilly Anglican community
- Develop positive relationships with the parents of students involved in the Music program to establish and maintain support for the necessary commitment to lessons, as well as ensemble rehearsals and performances.
- Teach groups of beginner students in the Immersion Program in Years 3-6 as required.
- Ensure opportunities for progression and artistic growth that go beyond the College gates.
- Guiding development of your specialty within the Music program by leading professional discussion and reflection of best practice in Instrumental Music programs.
- Lead/Conduct College Ensembles as requested by the Performing Arts Coordinator (T-12).
- Coordinate any arrangement and/or orchestration of music for ensembles as necessary/relevant.
- Support students by attending their performances throughout the year, this will include attendance at College and external events such as:
 - The Country Fair
 - End of Year Celebration Events
 - Music Recitals
 - Other performances as required.
