Pre-Kindergarten (Transition)

ALL SEASON UNIFORM

Pre-Kindergarten wear an all season uniform, with items to be worn as the weather dictates, although typically shorts are worn in Terms 1 and 4, and tracksuit jacket and long pants are worn in Terms 2 and 3.

College Green Jumper – optional to be worn if cold, but should only be worn under jacket

Hat: to be worn to and from the College, for all assemblies and in the playground:

Kindergarten to Year 2: bottle green bucket hat Years 3 to 6: green slouch

Shoes: black, polishable leather flat heeled lace up shoes. Black joggers, street, skate or casual style shoes are NOT permitted and do not meet WHS requirements. Shoes should be polished regularly.
